Bids for large items will be accepted until 12.30pm. There is no need to stay on the premises as winners will be contacted.

Large items can be collected on Sunday 24 March, 1pm to 2.30pm.

We regret that the site is unsuitable for wheelchair access at this time and children will not be given entry on this occasion. Please note that the auction does not include any items that are part of the building's Grade II listed status.
